There are a few things you should know when signing up to be a leader! We want to make sure you know what to expect...

- Every leader will be background checked through the campground. Please make sure all information on your application is correct.
- There will be a series of videos released that must be watched by every leader prior to camp. Your camp coordinator will send in verification that the training videos have been completed.
- Every group will be required to preform lice checks prior to camp. Again your camp coordinator will send in the verification that that has been completed.
- In order to keep camp cost down & provide the best experience for our campers, when you
 sign up you will be asked to choose 3 areas where you are willing to serve. We will try to
 place you in a meal serving rotation and at least one of the other rotations that you chose.
 We can not guarantee you will be placed in a given area. However, we do our best! You
 can find the description of each of the jobs on the next page.

This drastically cuts the cost of camp and we truly could not do it without YOU!

- Remember, camp is for kids! Everything we do, positive or negative, can have an impact on how campers respond in altar services. Love big, be kind and compassionate, participate in competition, but don't be so competitive that the kids walk away with a bad experience.
- NO nicotine, alcohol, or outside drinks or food allowed on campus!
- You are at camp not only to supervise your group, but most importantly to love and pour into ALL kids. Sometimes we have groups that come without leaders, and these campers need ministry too! Please be ready to jump in and minister to all of the kids that you encounter while at camp as needed.

Gaga Ball / Basketball Monitor
